## Assessment

Rodney Wilson is requesting **Rezoning** approval from Agricultural (AG) District to Residential Ranchette (R-5) District for proposed Lot 1 with an Agricultural Land Preservation (ALP) Overlay District and **Preliminary Plat** approval of Logan's Place approximately 31.33± acres, the proposed subdivision is located at approximately 7803 NE 160<sup>th</sup> Terrace.

Mr. Wilson would like to split this acreage off from their larger parcel of property to the south for his daughter to build a single-family residence on this proposed 5.00 acre lot (Lot #1).

### 2008 Comprehensive Plan Considerations

The Comprehensive Plan ("Plan") indicates that the subject property is located in the NATURAL RESOURCES TIER and within the Smithville Lake Watershed.

The following tables illustrate two (2) of the most pertinent policies shaped by the Plan. The first (1<sup>st</sup>) table shows the land use tiers and corresponding guidelines, and the second (2<sup>nd</sup>) explains the exceptions to the 20-acre minimum lot size policy as directed by the Plan.

\* The **Planning Tier Map** notes a special designation of areas within one mile of each city: "1-Mile Urban Coordination Sub-Tier" where advise-and-consent should be solicited from the designated city. The applicant will be required to submit a letter from the city of jurisdiction concerning the proposal. The Clay County Planning and Zoning Commission may consider the letter as a non binding city recommendation for Clay County to consider in their deliberations.

 \*\* A "Farmstead Dwelling" is the original residence built and initially occupied by a farm family, regardless of whether the current household occupant is associated with farming.

The subject request complies with the 2008 Comprehensive Plan, as the applicant is proposing an Agricultural Land Preservation (ALP) Overlay District on at least 5+ acres.

### **Character of the General Neighborhood**

Agricultural (AG) zoned land is each direction of the property. Residential Rural District (R-1) (Linda's Meadow First Plat) is located to the west. Owens Estates (AG) and AAA Estates (R-1) subdivisions are located to the north.

### **LDC Considerations**

The rezoning application was properly noticed in the Kearney Courier on October 13, 2016. Adjacent property owners within the statutory law mandated 1,000 foot distance were notified by means of a certified letter mailed on October 13, 2016 and November 18, 2016. The petitioner should fully address the five (5) rezoning criteria in the Land Development Code (LDC) which requires the following standards be met with a rezoning application (*Section 151-3.3 F*):

1. Whether or not the proposed amendment corrects an error or inconsistency or meets the challenge of a changing condition in the area;
2. Whether or not the proposed amendment is consistent with the *Comprehensive Plan* and the stated purpose and intent of Sec. 151-1.7;
3. Whether or not the proposed zoning district as a whole allows development that is compatible with existing uses and zoning of nearby property;
4. Whether or not the county and other service providers will be able to provide adequate public facilities and services to the subject property, while maintaining adequate levels of service to existing development; and
5. Whether or not the proposed amendment would result in significant adverse impacts on other property in the vicinity of the subject tract or on the environment, including air, water, noise, storm water management, and natural resources.

## **Outside Agency Review**

The Public Water Supply District No. 9 (PWSD #9) has indicated that “a water main currently runs down to the end of NE 160<sup>th</sup> Terrace and turns north to serve Owen’s Estates. The addition of one home on the existing 4” water main will not pose any problems or hinder us to serve the existing customers.”

The Clay County Highway Department has noted NE 160<sup>th</sup> Terrace is a chip and seal road with a temporary cul-de-sac at the east terminus of NE 160<sup>th</sup> Terrace. The property lies at the end of the cul-de-sac. Both lots can get driveway access off of the existing cul-de-sac.

The Clay County Public Health Center has given preliminary and final approval.

The Smithville Fire District serves this property. Future construction will need to comply with their fire protection codes. Any building plans shall be submitted and approved by the fire district before a building permit will be issued, and then prior to a Certificate of Occupancy being issued a letter of compliance is required from the fire district.

## **Findings**

Road Impact Fees (*RIF*) are required for the additional lot. The estimated total amount of RIF is \$2,062.50 and is subject to change at the time of payment based on the market price of material.

This case was tabled from the November 1, 2016 Planning and Zoning Commission meeting.

The applicant had intended to combine the now Lot 2 with a parcel to the south he was purchasing to make a much larger parcel, which would meet Exemption #1 of Section 151-8.1C of the 2011 Land Development Code. This would have meant that the applicant would not have had to plat the property. During research by staff it was discovered that this parcel to the south was platted as part of Short Lane Acres. So, the plat has been revised to include the remaining (Lot 2 - 26.33 acres) of agriculturally zoned land, as seen in *Attachment C* and your enclosed current preliminary and final plats.

## **Recommendations**

It is the recommendation of Staff that the request for **Rezoning** from Agricultural (AG) District to Residential Ranchette (R-5) District for proposed Lot 1 with an Agricultural Land Preservation (ALP) Overlay District be **approved** subject to the petitioner addressing all rezoning standards.

Staff recommends the **Preliminary Plat** of Logan’s Place be **approved**, with the following conditions as shown on Exhibit A:

### **Exhibit A**

1. Road Impact Fees (RIF) agreement recorded and fees paid according to agreement at same time as the recording of the Final Plat.
2. The following corrections to the recording copies of the Final Plat:
  - a. CHANGE: FIRM Community-Panel # 29047C0050 August 3, 2015
  - b. CHANGE: The west front 15’ U/E on Lot 1 and Lot 2 to 30’ U/E
  - c. ADD: 50’ build line along entire front of Lot 2



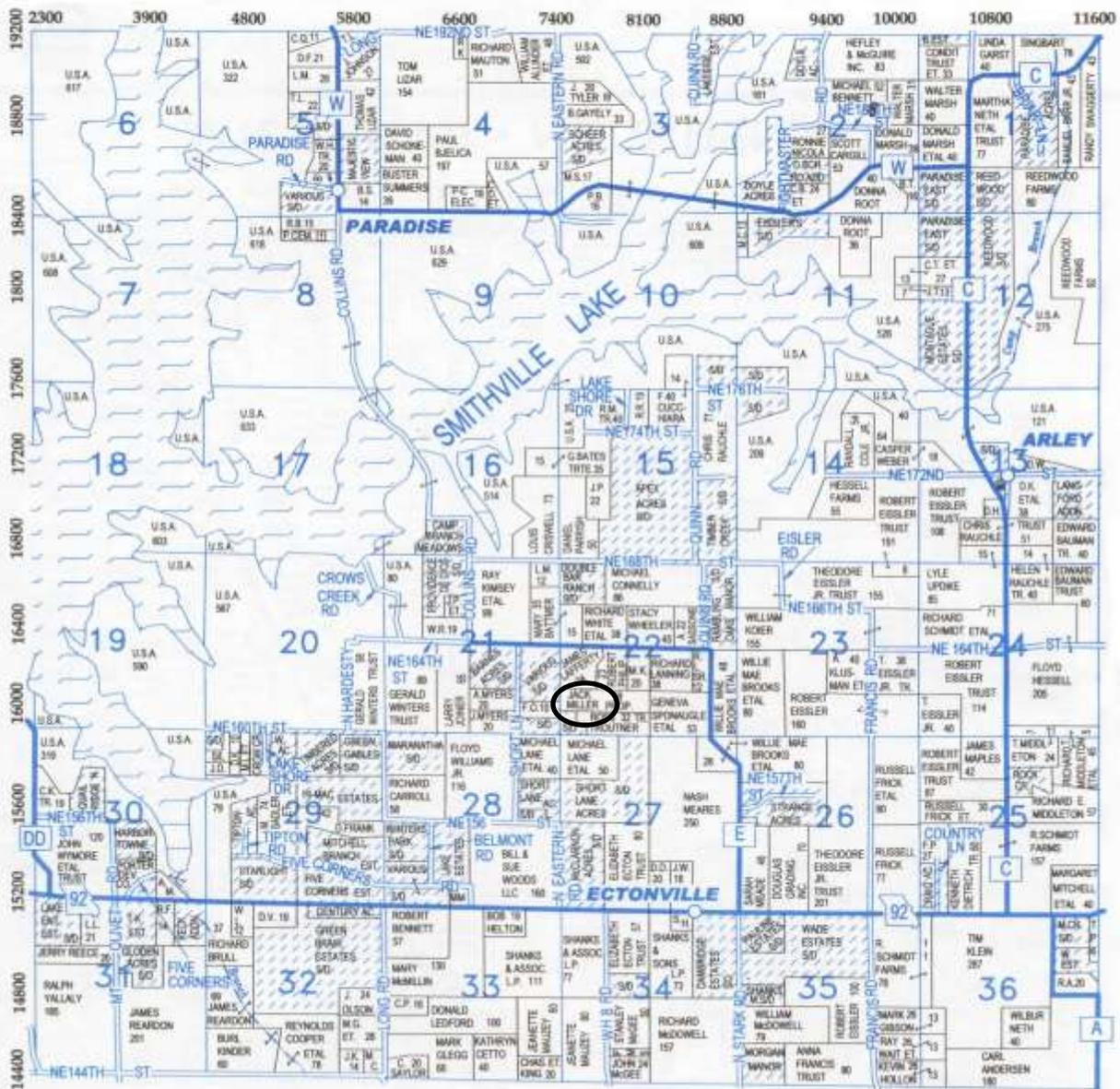

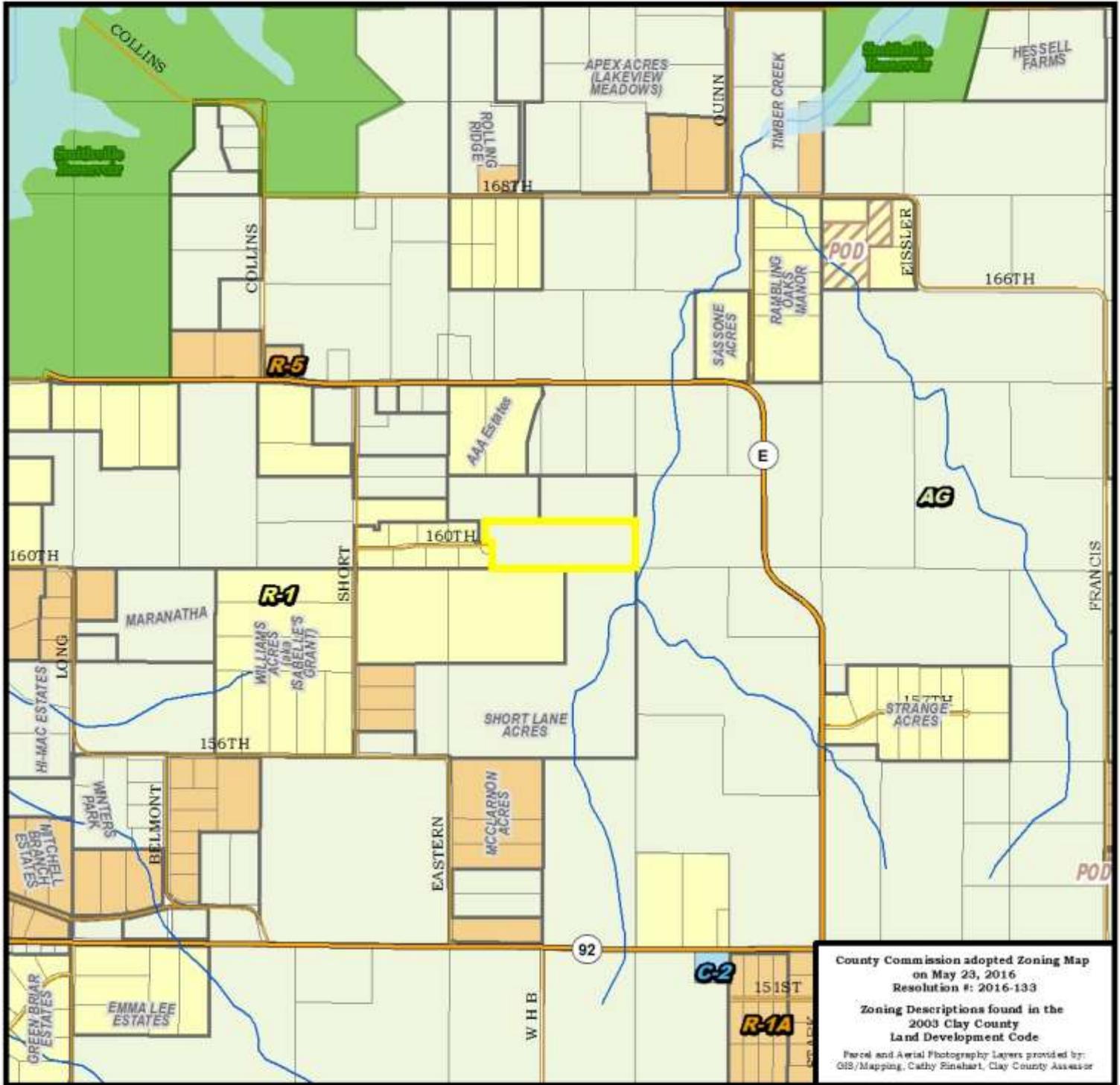

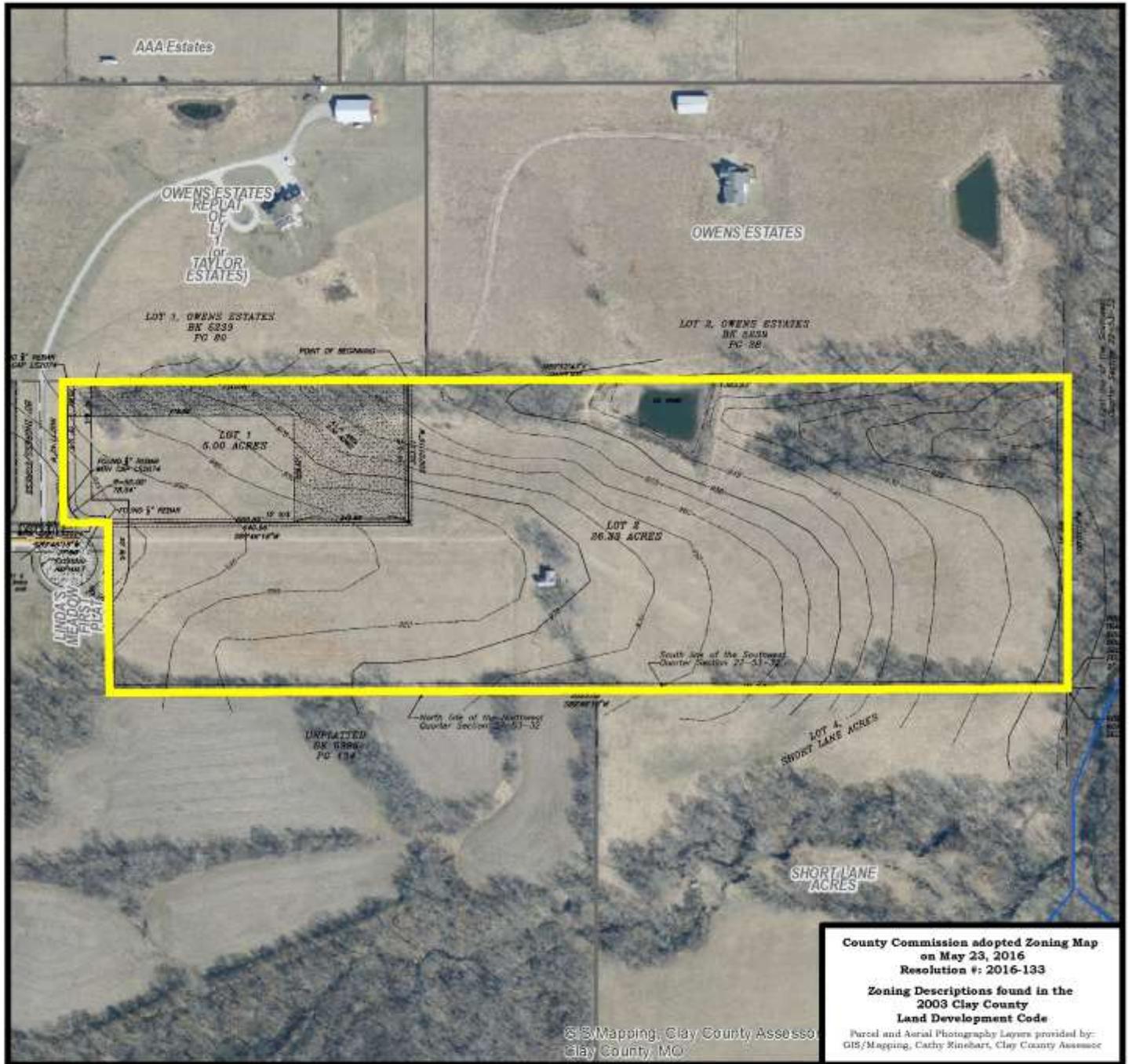
